

Refuge Worship Leader Training Program FAQ

What is the Refuge Worship Leader Training Program?

The Refuge Worship Leader Training Program is an opportunity for High School students with an interest in worship leading to receive training in worship leadership as well as opportunities to lead worship in various settings during the 2014-2015 school year.

What will I learn?

As part of the WLTP you will learn:

- What the Bible says about worship and leadership
- Practical worship leading skills in a number of areas, including worship planning, preparing for rehearsals, rehearsing, verbal leadership, musical leadership, spiritual leadership, and more.

How will I learn these things?

- We will meet once a month on Sunday afternoons to talk about worship leading. At these sessions, you'll get to hear from a number of experienced worship leaders, including John Hewlett, Jason Thomas, and others.
- You will be given brief reading assignments to complete and we will discuss the articles in our monthly meetings.
- You will have multiple opportunities to lead worship (vocally and/or with an instrument) in various settings around the church. You will receive coaching before and after these leadership opportunities from experienced worship leaders.

What are the requirements?

- Regular attendance at our monthly meetings – 4:00pm on the fourth Sunday of each month. (no meeting in December)
- Individual preparation at home (reading assigned articles, rehearsing on your own, etc.)
- Being responsible for all assigned leadership opportunities (arriving early, being prepared, etc.)
